STATEMENT	ANSWER	Level of Truth
Dr Hawkins talks about a high mountain pass where there are temptations that must be forgone in order to go through the pass	yes	840+
He also talks about the temptations of Power, Money and Recognition	yes	840+
What came to mind was that: These three things have no intrinsic value by themselves	yes	1,000
Power requires the company of others over which power is to be exercised	yes	1,000
Money has no value unless compared to what you can get with it	yes	1,000
Recognition requires another person/entity to recognise you	yes	1,000
The real temptation then is to remain on this side of the pass so that you do not have to be alone	yes	1,000
